Industry and Service Sector Earnings Statistics in July 2019

I. Abstract

- i. At the end of July, the total payroll employees was 7,988 thousand, increased by 46 thousand or 0.59% from the end of last month.
- ii. In July, the average regular earnings of full-time employees with Taiwan nationality (excluding foreigners and part-time employees) was NT\$44,209, 2.46% more than last July. After plus onto by irregular earnings such as bonuses and overtime pay, the total earnings came to NT\$55,831, 2.80% more than last July.
- iii. The average regular earnings of all employees (including full-time or part-time employees with Taiwan nationality or foreigners) in July was NT\$41,927, 2.42% more than last July. Plus onto by the irregular earnings such as bonuses and overtime pay, the total earnings came to NT\$53,017, 2.53% less than last July.
- **iv. The average total working hours in July was 183.0 hours,** increased by 6.9 hours than previous July.



II. Statistical Results

i. Employees

- (i) At the end of July, the total payroll employees was 7,988 thousand, increased by 46 thousand (or 0.59%) from the end of last month and increased by 89 thousand (or 1.13%) over the past year.
- (ii) The average payroll employees since January 2019 was 7,941 thousand, increased by 92 thousand (or 1.17%) than the same period of last year. The industrial sector increased by 0.66%,



while the service sector increased by 1.56%. Observing by industries, the Manufacturing



increased 15 thousand, among it, the Manufacture of Food Products and Prepared Animal Feeds increased by 4 thousand, Manufacture of Machinery and Equipment increased by 3 thousand, while the Manufacture of Electronic Parts and Components reduced by 4 thousand. Besides, Human Health Activities increased by 12 thousand, Support Service Activities increased by 11 thousand, Retail Trade and Accommodation and Food Service Activities increased by 10 thousand respectively.

ii. Turnover

- (i) In July, there were 46 thousand employees net increasing than previous month. The accession employees with newly hired or recalled reasons were 247 thousand, 64 thousand more than previous month. Among all industries, the Wholesale and Retail Trade increased the most of 16 thousand, followed by Manufacturing of 14 thousand increasing. The separation employees with quit, layoff, or retire reasons were 201 thousand, 23 thousand more than last month. Accommodation and Food Service Activities increased the most of 7 thousand, followed by Wholesale and Retail Trade of 6 thousand increasing. After separation and accession offset in all industries, the employees showed a net increase of 46 thousand.
- (ii) In July, the accession rate was 3.11%, 0.81 percentage points more than previous month and 0.08 percentage points less than last July. Meanwhile, the separation rate in July was 2.53%, 0.29 percentage points more than last month and 0.02 percentage points less than last July.
- (iii) The average accession rate since January 2019 was 2.35%, the average separation rate was 2.25%, decreased by 0.05 and 0.04 percentage points over the same period of the previous year, respectively.



iii. Average monthly earnings

- (i) In July, the average regular earnings of full-time employees with Taiwan nationality was NT\$44,209, 0.39% more than previous month and 2.46% more than last July. After plus onto by irregular earnings such as bonuses and overtime pay, the total earnings came to NT\$55,831. The total earnings increased 8.83% from the previous month and increased 2.80% from the same month of last year, due to the partial companies grant bonuses in this month. The average regular earnings since January was NT\$43,914, 2.37% more than the same period of last year.
- (ii) The average regular earnings of all employees (including full-time or part-time employees with Taiwan nationality or foreigners) in July was NT\$41,927, 0.40% more than last month and 2.42% more than the same month of last year. The irregular earnings in July was NT\$11,090, 62.30% more than previous month and 2.92% more than the same month of last year. After regular and irregular earnings combination, the total earnings came to NT\$53,017, 9.10% more than previous month and 2.53% more than last July.

- (iii) The average regular earnings of all employees since January 2019 was NT\$41,702, 2.32% more than the same period of last year. The total earnings increased by 1.81% compared with the same period of last year. After removing the price factor, the real regular earnings increased by 1.78% and the real total earnings grew 1.27%.
- (iv) Since with fewer working hours, the average regular earnings of part-time employees in July was NT\$17,960. The regular hourly earnings was NT\$177 on average, 2.75% less than last month and 4.73% more than last July. Plus onto by bonuses, and overtime pay, the average total earnings was NT\$18,423, 1.50% more than previous month and 0.67% less than last July, about 34.7% of all employees. The average regular earnings since January 2019 was NT\$18,131.



iv. Hours of work

(i) The average total working hours of all employees in July was 183.0 hours, an increase of 23.8 hours from the previous month, mainly due to more working days this month. The working hour increased by 6.9 hours than previous July.

(ii) The average total working hours since January 2019 was 166.3 hours, 0.2 hours less than the same period of last year. The regular working hours increased by 0.1 hours, while the overtime decreased by 0.3 hours.




v. Overtime and overtime pay

(i) The average overtime of all employees in July was 7.6 hours, 0.3 hours less than last month and 0.6 hours less than last July. The average overtime since January 2019 was 7.8 hours, 0.3 hours less than the same period of

last year.

(ii) The overtime pay in July was NT\$1,760, 5.73% less than previous month and 4.61% less than last July. The average overtime pay since January 2019 was NT\$1,816, 0.44% more than the same period of last year.
