Earnings and Productivity Statistics in January 2017


I. Abstract

- i. At the end of January, the total nonagricultural payroll employees was 7,500 thousand, increased by 4 thousand or 0.06% from last month and increased by 69 thousand or 0.92% than last January.
- ii. The average total earnings (including regular and irregular earnings) in January was NT\$93,144, affected by year-end bonuses and performance bonuses granted mostly in this month, it was 95.16% more than last month and was 23.66% more than last January.
- **iii. The average regular earnings was NT\$ 39,679,** 0.13% less than last month and 1.37% more than the same month of last year, while the irregular earnings was NT\$53,465, 47.78% more than last January.
- **iv.** The average working hour in January was 153.0 hours. Since the working day was less in this month with Chinese New Year Holidays, the working hour was 23.4 hours fewer than last month and 20.8 hours less than the same month of last year.

II. Statistical Results

i. Employees

- (i) At the end of January 2017, the total payroll employees was 7,500 thousand, increased by 4 thousand (or 0.06%) from last month. Among all industries, the service sector shared 56.58%.
- (ii) Compared the same month with last year, payroll employees increased by 69 thousand (or 0.92%). The Industrial sector increased 0.49%, while the service sector increased by 1.26%. Among all industries, the largest increasing in payroll employees was Manufacturing (18 thousand), followed by Wholesale and Retail Trade, Accommodation and Food Service Activities (both were 16 thousand).




ii. Turnover

- (i) There was a net accession of 4 thousand employees in January. The total accession in January was 151 thousand, which was 14 thousand more than last month. Meanwhile, there was a separation of 147 thousand, 18 thousand more than last month, showed a net accession of 4 thousand.
- (ii) The accession rate in January was 2.01%, increased by 0.17 percentage points than last month and increased by 0.01 percentage points than last January.
- (iii) The separation rate in January was 1.95%, increased by 0.23 percentage points than last month, while remained the same as in last January.

iii. Average monthly earnings

- (i) The average total earnings in January was NT\$93,144. The average regular earnings was NT\$39,679, irregular earnings (including year-end bonuses, performance bonuses, and overtime pay) was NT\$53,465.
- (ii) Affected by year-end bonuses and performance bonuses granted mostly in this month, it was 95.16% more than last month and was 23.66% more than last January.
- (iii) The regular earnings in January was 0.13% less than last month and 1.37% more than the same month of last year. After deflating by the consumer price index increasing rate of 2.25%, the real regular earnings was reduced 0.86%.



iv. Hours of work

The average monthly working hour in January was 153.0 hours. Since the working day was less in this month with Chinese New Year Holidays, the working hour was 23.4 hours fewer than last month and 20.8 hours less than the same month of last year. The regular working hour reduced 20.8 hours and overtime was remained the same.

Working hour of January



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attendance reward) and irregular (over-time, annul bonus, flexible bonus not paid by month) earnings of employees on payroll, but exclude the non-working reward such as insurance and pension.

3. Number of employees at the end of this month = Number of employees at the end of last month + Number of accession in this month - Number of separation in this month. However, the formula above does not apply on annual average data since the annual employees number is mean of a year not the number at the end of a year.

4. Both Industry & Services and Services Sectors statistics covered Education Industry (only other education and educational support activities are included) since January 2009.
