Industry and Service Sector Earnings Statistics in January 2023

i. Employee

- (i) At the end of January, the total payroll employees were 8,176 thousand, decreased by 25 thousand (or 0.30%) than the previous month because of the job transfer and the separation of temporary employees around the Chinese New Year. Among it, Manufacturing decreased by 14 thousand, Support Service Activities decreased by 4 thousand.
- (ii) Compared to the same month last year, the employees increased by 7 thousand (or 0.09%). Among it, Arts, Entertainment & Recreation increased by 5 thousand, and Information & Communication, Financial & Insurance Activities, and Other Service Activities (including Hairdressing & Beauty Treatment, etc.) increased by 4 thousand, while Wholesale & Retail Trade and Transportation & Storage decreased by 6 thousand and 3 thousand, respectively.

ii. Average Monthly Earnings

- (i) In January, mainly affected by the Chinese New Year, the average regular earnings of full-time employees with Taiwan nationality (excluding the foreigners and part-time employees) was NT\$47,939, increased by 1.10% than the previous month and increased by 2.57% than the same month last year. The irregular earnings such as year-end bonuses, performance bonuses and overtime pays was NT\$66,878. After adding the irregular earnings, the average total earnings was NT\$114,817, increased by 88.74% than the previous month and increased by 1.70% than the same month last year because most companies paid the year-end bonuses and performance bonuses in January. After removing the price factor, the real regular earnings decreased by 0.46% than the same month last year.
- (ii) In January, the average regular earnings of all employees (including full-time and part-time employees with Taiwan nationality and foreigners) was NT\$45,376, increased by 0.97% than the previous month and increased by 2.30% than the same month last year. The irregular earnings such as year-end bonuses, performance bonuses and overtime pays was NT\$62,360. After adding the irregular earnings, the average total earnings was NT\$107,736, increased by 87.30% than the previous month and increased by 1.52% than the same month last year. After removing the price factor, the real regular earnings decreased by 0.72% than the same month last year.
- (iii) Since the working hours of part-time employees were fewer, in January,

the average regular earnings of part-time employees was NT\$18,392 and the regular hourly earnings was NT\$207, increased by 4.02% than the previous month and increased by 0.49% than the same month last year. The average total earnings was NT\$22,252, increased by 10.12% than the previous month and increased by 1.62% than the same month last year.

iii. Hours of Work

- (i) In January, the working hours of all employees were 136.3 hours. Mainly affected by the Chinese New Year with more days off, the working hours decreased by 39.8 hours than the previous month.
- (ii) Compared to the same month last year, the working hours of all employees decreased by 31.2 hours, mainly affected by the Chinese New Year (Chinese New Year's holidays were in early February last year). The regular working hours decreased by 30.8 hours and overtime decreased by 0.4 hours.
