# **Industry and Service Sector Earnings Statistics in January 2024**

## i. Employee

- (i) At the end of January, the total payroll employees were 8,444 thousand, increased by 4 thousand (or 0.05%) than the previous month. Among it, both Wholesale & Retail Trade and Accommodation & Food Service Activities increased by 3 thousand.
- (ii) Compared to the same month last year, the employees increased by 28 thousand (or 0.33%). Among it, Accommodation & Food Service Activities increased by 12 thousand, and both Wholesale & Retail Trade and Human Health & Social Work Activities increased by 10 thousand, while Manufacturing decreased by 35 thousand.

## ii. Average Monthly Earnings

- (i) In January, the average regular earnings of full-time employees with Taiwan nationality (excluding the foreigners and part-time employees) was NT\$48,616, increased by 1.31% than the previous month and increased by 2.26% than the same month last year. The irregular earnings such as bonuses and overtime pays was NT\$42,684. After adding the irregular earnings, the average total earnings was NT\$91,300, increased by 50.61% than the previous month due to the payment of year-end and performance bonuses, and decreased by 18.46% than the same month last year because the Chinese New Year was in January last year, most companies paid the year-end and performance bonuses. After removing the price factor, the real regular earnings increased by 0.46% than the same month last year.
- (ii) In January, the average regular earnings of all employees (including full-time and part-time employees with Taiwan nationality and foreigners) was NT\$46,140, increased by 1.22% than the previous month and increased by 2.30% than the same month last year. The irregular earnings was NT\$39,656. After adding the irregular earnings, the average total earnings was NT\$85,796, increased by 49.54% than the previous month and decreased by 18.54% than the same month last year. After removing the price factor, the real regular earnings increased by 0.50% than the same month last year.
- (iii) Since the working hours of part-time employees were fewer, in January, the average regular earnings of part-time employees was NT\$20,605 and the regular hourly earnings was NT\$204, increased by 2.00% than the previous month and decreased by 1.45% than the same month last year. The average total earnings was NT\$22,558, increased by 8.00% than the previous month and decreased by 4.27% than the same month last year.

## iii. Hours of Work

- (i) In January, the working hours of all employees were 178.5 hours, increased by 6.6 hours than the previous month.
- (ii) Compared to the same month last year, the working hours of all employees increased by 41.5 hours, because the Chinese New Year was in January last year with more days off. The regular working hours increased by 40.9 hours and overtime increased by 0.6 hours.
