

## Manpower Survey Results in July 2020

- Total employment increased by 21,000(+0.18%) in July to 11,498,000, however, it decreased by 13,000(-0.11%) when compared with that of the previous year.

--Employment in agriculture and the services-providing sector increased by 1,000(+0.16%) and 22,000(+0.31%) in July, respectively; by contrast, the goods-producing sector decreased by 1,000(-0.03%) in July.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture and the goods-producing sector decreased by 12,000(-2.16%) and 23,000(-0.57%) in July, respectively; the services-providing sector increased by 23,000(+0.33%).

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- The unemployment rate rose by 0.04 percentage points to 4.00 percent in July; however, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate declined by 0.07 percentage points to 3.90 percent.

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate rose by 0.18 percentage points in July.

--The number of unemployed persons was 479,000 in July, which increased by 6,000(+1.30%) and 22,000(+4.85%) from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.

- Labor force participation rate was 59.20 percent in July, which rose by 0.13 percentage points but declined by 0.08 percentage points from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.
