

Manpower Survey Results in February 2015

- **Total employment increased by 1,000(+0.01%) in February to 11,160,000, moreover, it also increased by 141,000(+1.29%) when compared with that of the previous year.**

--Employment in agriculture and the goods-producing sector increased by 1,000(+0.14%) and 1,000(+0.01%) respectively in February, however, the services-providing sector remained the same as the previous month.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 7,000(+1.25%), 41,000(+1.01%) and 94,000(+1.46%) respectively in February.

- **The unemployment rate declined by 0.02 percentage points to 3.69 percent in February, moreover, the seasonally adjusted unemployment also dropped by 0.04 percentage points to 3.74 percent in February.**

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate and the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate declined by 0.40 and 0.30 percentage points respectively in February.

--The number of unemployed persons in February was 428,000, a decrease of 2,000(-0.44%) and 42,000(-8.90%) from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.

Labor force participation rate was 58.56 percent in February, which dropped by 0.04 percentage points from the previous month; in contrast, it rose by 0.12 percentage points from that of the previous year.
