

Manpower Survey Results in June 2014

- Total employment increased by 10,000(+0.09%) in June to 11,062,000, moreover, it also increased by 103,000(+0.94%) when compared with that of the previous year.

--Employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector, and the services-providing sector increased by 2,000(+0.46%), 5,000(+0.12%), and 2,000(+0.03%) respectively in June.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector, and the services-providing sector increased by 3,000(+0.65%), 42,000(+1.07%), and 57,000(+0.89%) respectively in June.

- The unemployment rate rose by 0.07 percentage points to 3.92 percent in June, in contrast, the seasonally adjusted unemployment declined by 0.02 percentage points to 3.97 percent.

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate and the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate declined by 0.22 and 0.21 percentage points respectively in June.

--The number of unemployed persons in June was 451,000, an increase of 8,000(+1.87%) but a decrease of 22,000(-4.55%) from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.

Labor force participation rate was 58.45 percent in June, which rose by 0.06 percentage points from the previous month and 0.07 percentage points from that of the previous year.
