

Manpower Survey Results in July 2014

- **Total employment increased by 29,000(+0.26%) in July to 11,091,000, moreover, it also increased by 107,000(+0.98%) when compared with that of the previous year.**

--Employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector, and the services-providing sector increased by 3,000(+0.48%), 8,000(+0.22%), and 18,000(+0.27%) respectively in July.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector, and the services-providing sector increased by 3,000(+0.49%), 43,000(+1.10%), and 61,000(+0.94%) respectively in July.

- **The unemployment rate rose by 0.10 percentage points to 4.02 percent in July, in contrast, the seasonally adjusted unemployment declined by 0.02 percentage points to 3.95 percent.**

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate and the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate declined by 0.23 and 0.24 percentage points respectively in July.

--The number of unemployed persons in July was 464,000, an increase of 13,000(+2.81%) but a decrease of 23,000(-4.71%) from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.

Labor force participation rate was 58.63 percent in July, which rose by 0.18 percentage points from the previous month and 0.08 percentage points from that of the previous year.
