

Manpower Survey Results in July 2018

- Total employment increased by 25,000(+0.22%) in July to 11,443,000; moreover, it increased by 83,000(+0.73%) when compared with that of the previous year.

--Employment in agriculture sector, the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 2,000(+0.35%), 8,000(+0.21%) and 14,000(+0.22%) in July, respectively.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 5,000(+0.92%), 20,000(+0.51%) and 57,000 (+0.85%) in July, respectively.

- The unemployment rate rose by 0.11 percentage points to 3.81 percent in July; moreover, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate rose by 0.01 percentage points to 3.69 percent.

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate fell by 0.03 percentage points in July.

--The number of unemployed persons was 453,000 in July, it increased by 14,000(+3.15%) from the previous month, however, it decreased by 1,000(-0.20%) from that of the previous year.

- Labor force participation rate was 59.09 percent in July, which rose by 0.17 percentage points from the previous month; moreover, it rose by 0.18 percentage points from that of the previous year.
