

Manpower Survey Results in April 2019

- **Total employment increased by 2,000(+0.02%) in April to 11,480,000, moreover, it also increased by 74,000(+0.66%) when compared with that of the previous year.**

--Employment in agriculture and the goods-producing sector increased by 1,000(+0.20%) and 1,000 (+0.04%) respectively, by contrast, the services-providing sector decreased by 1,000 (0.00%) in April.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 5,000(+0.82%), 14,000(+0.34%) and 56,000 (+0.83%), respectively.

- **The unemployment rate declined by 0.01 percentage points to 3.67 percent in April; the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate, by contrast, rose by 0.01 percentage points to 3.73 percent.**

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate rose by 0.03 percentage points in April.

--The number of unemployed persons was 437,000 in April, it decreased by 1,000(-0.22%) and but increased by 6,000(+1.48%) from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.

- **Labor force participation rate was 59.06 percent in April, which remained the same as the previous month; however, it rose by 0.20 percentage points from that of the previous year.**
