

Manpower Survey Results in May 2019

- Total employment increased by 4,000(+0.03%) in May to 11,484,000, moreover, it also increased by 73,000(+0.64%) when compared with that of the previous year.

--Employment in agriculture and the goods-producing sector decreased by 1,000(-0.20%) and 2,000 (-0.05%) respectively, by contrast, the services-providing sector increased by 7,000 (+0.10%) in May.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 5,000(+0.88%), 11,000(+0.26%) and 58,000 (+0.85%), respectively.

- The unemployment rate was 3.67 percent in May, which remained the same as the previous month; the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate rose by 0.02 percentage points to 3.75 percent.

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate rose by 0.04 percentage points in May.

--The number of unemployed persons was 437,000 in May, it remained the same but increased by 7,000(+1.68%) from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.

- Labor force participation rate was 59.07 percent in May, which increased by 0.01 percentage points and 0.21 percentage points from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.
