The Price Indices for July 2015

Consumer Price Indices (CPI)

The CPI in July 2015 (2011=100) decreased 0.13% from the preceding month. Prices of vegetables and fruits declined 4.87% and 2.66%. Prices of garments fell 3.96% for promotion. Prices of fuels and lubricants moved down 2.80%. However, prices of entertainment expenses went up 2.40% due to summer vacation. The general CPI excluding fruits, vegetables, and energy, i.e. core CPI, increased 0.15%.

The annual change of CPI in July 2015, compared with the same month of 2014, moved down 0.66%. Prices of fuels and lubricants dropped 24.74%. The lowering prices of gas and electricity brought prices of water, electricity, and gas supply declining 9.40%. Prices of garments decreased 2.56%. In the other hand, prices of vegetables, meat, and food away from home rose 4.06%, 2.44%, and 1.69%. Prices of entertainment expenses also went up 0.68%. The core CPI increased 0.66%.


For the first seven months, the CPI decreased 0.65% over the same period of previous year. Prices of commodities fell 2.91%, but prices of services rose 1.06%. The core CPI increased 0.85%.

Wholesale Price Indices (WPI)

The WPI in July 2015 decreased 0.69% from the preceding month. Since prices of crude petroleum and natural gas moved down 4.66%, prices of petroleum and coal products declined 4.12%, and prices of chemical materials fell 2.04%. Prices of farm products and basic metals went down 6.66% and 2.28% respectively. Prices of electronic parts and components rose 0.38%.

The annual change of WPI in July 2015, compared with the same month of 2014, decreased 9.98%. Prices of crude petroleum and natural gas dropped 42.88%. Prices of petroleum and coal products went down 34.98%, prices of chemical materials declined 18.07%, and prices of basic metals fell 17.21%. Prices of water supply, electricity, and gas moved down 12.52%. The WPI for domestic sales excluding imports decreased 10.59%, import price index fell 14.25%, and export price index declined 5.65%.

For the first seven months, the WPI went down 9.11% over the same period of previous year.
